Interview with Supported Internship Coordinator (Year 1) Ricci Colla Reported by LC (Year 2 Intern)

LC - How long have you worked with the charity and what influenced you to become a mentor?

RC - I have worked on and off with SAMEE for 9 years. I was influenced by SAMEEs focus on the individuals rather than checking boxes. Overall, the goal is to enable the interns to be able to have a functioning business. Their current goal is working on how to introduce themselves.

RC - We have approximately 15 mentors on the Supported Internship

RC - Samee was established in 2016; its main goal is to help disabled individual become more financially independent through the means of self-employment.

RC - New mentors can join by speaking to Rob, who is our Young Person Lead. Rob would then invite them in to spend time and speak to our interns. So, they can understand what it's about and see how well they interact. They will then come to a decision and get back to you.
